




## Location









# TASMAN ROOM \_







This space can be used with the adjacent foyer and Boardwalk Gallery for larger events.



This premium dining venue overlooks the River Derwent, Tasman Bridge, and the neighbouring marina.








## André Kropp

#### **Executive Chef**

André's 30-year career has spanned the globe, exposing him to much of the world's produce but it was Tasmania that he fell in love with and decided to call

home. "Here in Tasmania the freshest and best produce is never far from the plate."

André oversees more than 70 chefs across the Wrest Point property, he is the current Vice President of the Australian Culinary Federation (an Industry Organisation representing professional chefs, cooks, apprentices and culinary students) and regularly participates in international cooking competitions, including the Culinary Olympics and World Cup.

André was a member of the Australian National Culinary Team, winning gold and silver medals at the 2008 and 2012 Culinary Olympics in Germany, as well as the Singapore Culinary Challenge. He was fortunate to also be selected to represent Australia at the international final of the MLA Black Box Culinary Challenge, where his team placed third in the world. André is so respected he was invited to cook for 300 VIP guests at Savour China in Shanghai.

Passionate about our island state, Andre believes in showcasing the very best and freshest Tasmanian produce whenever possible and tells fellow chefs he is lucky to be able to work with some of the best produce in the world.



#### **Robin Kelly**

#### Senior Chef de Cuisine

Robin started his career at Wrest Point in 1992 as an apprentice chef, the foundation for a stellar career which has taken him around the world, and back to where it all began.

Robin has worked within 5-star hotels in Australia and the UK, including as Chef de Partie at Balmoral Hotel in Edinburgh, Scotland, and as Senior Chef de Partie at a Michelin-starred restaurant in London, and worked in all parts of the kitchen with talented chefs, where he developed a passion for patisserie and chocolate.

Over the last 20 years Robin has been a vital contributor to each kitchen team at Wrest Point and oversees the preparation of meals for functions and events (catering to groups of 20 to 1600 people), production and the pastry kitchens.

Robin is a valued member of the Tasmanian branch of the Australia Culinary Federation, where he regularly competes in National Chef competitions. In August 2015, Robin was awarded Tasmanian Chef of the Year, and travelled to Shanghai to cook for 300 VIPs at the Savour Tasmania event.

Working with Tasmania's first-class produce every day is Robin's favourite part of the job.

"It's great to know where the produce has come from, what environment it was grown or farmed in and to know that the environment is so unspoilt."



#### Paul Keenan

#### Senior Sous Chef

Paul's remarkable journey began in the heart of hospitality, as a Kitchen Hand at Wrest Point in 1993. This role marked the inception of his global career, and his

dedication and determination quickly propelled him forward.

In 1994, Paul was offered a Cookery apprenticeship, and over four years showcased his skills in various culinary competitions, earning silver and gold medals in The Hobart Salon Culinaire.

In 2005 Paul ventured to the UK and worked as Senior Chef de Partie at Warren House in Surrey, under the mentorship of Paul Bellingham. Upon returning to Australia in 2007, Paul assumed the role of Junior Sous Chef at Kingfisher Eco Resort Fraser Island, managing Seabel Restaurant. In 2009, Paul rejoined Wrest Point as a Demi Chef, working under Kent Sullivan in The Point Revolving Restaurant.

Paul then moved to Flinders Island in 2011 and worked as Head Chef at the Furneaux Tavern. This was followed by a relocation to Melbourne in 2012 to work as a Sous Chef, and quickly assumed the role of Head Chef at Crowded House in Williamstown.

Paul returned to Wrest Point in 2017 and has since showcased his culinary expertise and excelled in various outlets. He was assigned the role of Senior Sous Chef in Events in 2023 which he thoroughly enjoys.

"I have always had a common interest in the hospitality industry with the goal of becoming a chef from an early age."


